Ruby Blue (Hughes Craft Distillery), Lisburn

Makers of wonderful fruit liqueurs and Ireland's first potato distilled vodka. The fruit liqueurs feature in many of our cocktails and the vodka is exceptionally smooth with subtle notes of vanilla and crisp apple.

Fevertree

After discovering that the majority of mixers were full of preservatives, cheap aromatics and artificial sweeteners the creators of Fevertree started researching recipes as far back as 1620 and the first bottle of Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water was produced in 2005. The brand name was chosen due to fever tree being the colloquial name for the cinchona tree in which quinine, a key ingredient for tonic, is found. The following flavours are available here:-

The mineral rich spring water from their Wexford well is so good, it's been pilfered and poached since 1825, hence the name. Their citrus was the first of their tonics made by extracting the mineral rich water and sweetening it with sugar beets before adding cinchona bark and other botanicals. Then they blend in Florida orange and Irish rosemary to give it a zesty lift of citrus and herb. The same attention goes into their other flavours.
